### CEDAR GROVE SAINTS

### **STEPHENSON JAGUARS**

The defending Trail to the Title champions Cedar Grove Saints took the first step towards a repeat with a 20-0 first round win over the Champion Chargers.

Zack Bell scored a pair of touchdowns for the Saints including his second one to end an almost eight minute drive to open the second half to push the lead to 14-0.

A one-yard touchdown run by Dequarrion Trammell in the fourth quarter sealed the win for the Saints.

Cedar Grove is in the semifinals for the 13th season and are looking to become the first team to win repeat titles twice.

### **REDAN RAIDERS**

The Redan Raiders keep making history this season remaining undefeated after shutting out the Freedom Rams 20-0 in first round action.

Redan led 6-0 at the half on a 21-yard touchdown pass from Jervontae Barber to Tyler Clark. Benjamin Jackson and Demario Hopkins added second half scores as the defense allowed just 77 yards of offense by the Rams. Hopkins added an interception to end the first half.

Redan's win was its first playoff victory as it continues its first ever undefeated regular season to advance to the semifinals against Chapel Hill.

### 20th Annual Trail to the Title Championship First Round Notes

The 2024 Trail to the Title Championship semifinals matches two undefeated region champions against a pair of region runners-up for a shot at the championship next week at Cobb Stadium.

The defending champion Cedar Grove Saints (7-0) are undefeated and take on Region 3 runner-up Stephenson Jaguars (4-3) in a rematch of last year's championship game in the opening semifinal game at Cobb Stadium set for 9:00 am.

Cedar Grove defeated Champion (5-2) 20-0 in the first round of the playoffs while Stephenson upended Region 1 champion Chamblee (4-3) by an identical 20-0 score.

The Saints are in the semifinals for the 13th time and face 14-time semifinalist Stephenson. Cedar Grove is 5-2 all time against Stephenson in the playoffs.

The second game of the day has undefeated Region 3 champion Redan (7-0) facing off with Region 4 runner-up Chapel Hill (6-1) set for 10:30 am at Cobb Stadium.

Redan finished its first ever undefeated regular season and region championship and moved into the semifinals with a 20-0 win over the Freedom Rams (3-4). Chapel Hill reached the semifinals for the eighth time and for the fourth consecutive season with a tough 20-14 win over the previously undefeated Lithonia Bulldogs.

The Trail to the Title can have a repeat champion since the 2014-15 seasons (Cedar Grove) with Cedar Grove returning to defend its 2023 title. Stephenson is the only other former Trail to the Title champion to repeat in the title game.

### 20th Annual Trail to the Title Championship Notes

The 2024 Trail to the Title Championship marks the 20th year (no season in 2020) of the DeKalb County Middle School Football Championship playoffs.

Stephenson (2004, 2005, 2009, 2011, 2016, 2022) holds the county record with six Trail to the Title championships followed by Miller Grove (2006, 2008, 2010) and Cedar Grove (2014, 2015, 2023) with three. Tucker (2013, 2017), Champion (2019), Lithonia (2012) and the now closed Avondale (2007) are the other title winners.

Stephenson is the only team to reach the title game nine times, winning six. Stephenson (2004-2005) and Cedar Grove (2014-2015) are the only teams to win back-to-back titles. Miller Grove reached the title game three times, winning all three championships. (2006, 2008, 2010)

Cedar Grove joined the championship group in 2014 with its thrilling 20-14 overtime win against 2014 defending champion Tucker and repeated in 2015 with a 22-0 win over Tucker. Cedar Grove has reached the championship four times and is now 3-1.

The 2013 title game won by Tucker 22-20 over Chapel Hill featured two first time finalists as the teams made the number of teams to reach the final climb to 10. The 2013 championship was also just the second to feature two undefeated teams, the first coming in 2011, a 6-0 victory by Stephenson over Bethune in overtime. A third and fourth meeting of undefeated teams came in the 2015 title game with Cedar Grove and Tucker meeting for the second consecutive season and Stephenson and Tucker in 2016.

Tucker reached the title game five consecutive years (2013-2017) and is the only team to accomplish the feat. Columbia became the first team to return to back-to-back championship games in 2010 since Stephenson made it back-to-back in 2004 and 2005. Cedar Grove became the fourth team to make back-to-back championship game appearances with consecutive wins in 2014 and 2015.

Bethune (2008, 2011, 2017) became just the fifth team to reach the title game three times with its third appearance in 2017.

The addition of Champion (2019) put the number of teams to reach the title game at 12.
