DRUID HILLS TOPS IN ALL-SPORTS FOR FIRST TIME

In one of the most exciting all-sports trophy races in the 43-year history of the event, Druid Hills claimed the top prize for the first time ever with 290.0 points to the 289.5 of runner-up Chamblee, 288.0 of Dunwoody, 267.5 of Lakeside and 261.0 of Tucker in rounding out the remainder of the top five.

VOLLEYBALL HISTORY

Volleyball returned to DeKalb County high schools for the first time in nearly two decades during the fall of 2000 campaign.

Boys and girls on the local level both once played volleyball on a yearly basis from the late 1960s until the sport was finally dropped following the 1980 season.

Led by private school powers Westminster, Marist and Woodward Academy, volleyball remained alive as primarily a metro Atlanta push through the rest of the 1980s and the entire 1990s.

Enthusiasm in the sport continued to pick up steam behind strong showings by the USA men and women on the Olympic and international scenes. The 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta, in particular, seemed to generate increased excitement and participation in volleyball.

Cobb County has ranked as the most successful among public schools from the start in the battle for volleyball supremacy. Walton, Sprayberry and Lassiter stand at the top of this crowded list.

Volleyball, however, remains a work in progress outside of the metro Atlanta area. Savannah is one strong exception to this case, with Savannah Christian and Savannah Country Day heading up a long list of eligible and talented entrants.

Athens, Augusta, Brunswick, Carrollton, Cartersville, Dallas, Dalton, Fairburn, Forsyth, Gainesville, Loganville, Monroe, Rome and Villa Rica are among the other areas that have seen dramatic growth among both the public and private school participation in volleyball over the last five years.

The Georgia High School Association (GHSA) has taken notice of this increased enthusiasm, sanctioning the state tournament for the first time beginning in the 1993 season.

Marist, Woodward Academy and Westminster took turns dominating the state field in an open event for all classifications from 1993-98.

Coach **Sergio Stadler**'s Marist machine claimed a pair of state titles during this period, running the table in both 1994 and 1997. Woodward Academy matched that total with victorious efforts in both 1993 and 1996, while Westminster walked away with the top prize in 1995.

The state championship hunt was opened considerably with the decision to divide the field up into classifications starting in 1998.

Two state trophies were thus up for grabs in both 1998 and 1999, with Walton and Marist claiming consecutive triumphs in AAAA and AAA respectively in those years.

The field was divided even more in the fall of 2000. Four separate prizes were handed out in AAAAA, AAAA, AAA and AA/A.

Walton (AAAAA), Marist (AAAA), Westminster (AAA) and Savannah Country Day (AA/A) earned state crowns in those respective divisions.

Lakeside (7AAAAA) and Avondale (4AAA) shined brightest in volleyball's return to DeKalb County in 2000, claiming area tournament titles in their respective leagues. Cross Keys also earned a sectional tournament berth as the runnerup to Avondale in 4AAA.

Lakeside repeated as Area 7AAAAA champion in 2001, and Redan (7AAAAA), Columbia (1AAAA) and Druid Hills (1AAA) also snared state sectional tournament berths after placing second in their respective area clashes.

A new chapter was added in 2002, as Lakeside became the first DeKalb County school to qualify for the state tournament in AAAAA. Druid Hills joined Lakeside as area champions.

Chamblee, meanwhile, established a new county victory standard during the 2005 campaign, soaring to a stellar 56-8 showing that included a berth in the state Class AAAA Final Four.

Lakeside added another memorable performance to the local list of highlights in 2012, soaring all the way to the state Class AAAAA tournament semifinals on the way to posting a stellar 29-7 final overall record under coach **Angela Thompson**.

Dunwoody joined the select group of DeKalb County squads to shine in the state tournament during the 2013 season, advancing to the AAAAA semifinals behind victories over Warner Robins, Hiram and Apalachee. Coach **Doug Friedlander**'s Lady Wildcats posted a 29-14 final record.

The Lady Wildcats advanced to the AAAAA semifinals again in 2014 and 2015, finishing 43-5 and 37-15 respectively during those memorable campaigns.

2023 VOLLEYBALL IN REVIEW

Chamblee led the way among nine DeKalb County state volleyball qualifiers in 2023, advancing to at least the second round for the ninth time in the last 12 years.

Lorri Reynolds has been the head coach every year in that extended run of success, guiding the Lady Bulldogs to as far as the quarterfinals in three consecutive campaigns in 2016, 2017 and 2018.

Chamblee knocked off Ware County in the opening round of the 2023 state playoffs, sweeping three straight matches to prevail by a 3-0 final margin.

Traditional power McIntosh next ended the Lady Bulldog postseason march, scoring a 3-0 decision by the respective scores of 25-15, 25-6 and 25-15.

Chamblee thus ended another solid season with the final overall record of 19-20, besting the likes of such typically strong programs as Decatur (2-1) and Chattahoochee (2-0) along the way.

Several players stood out on the individual side for the Lady Bulldogs, led by junior outside hitter **McKenna Smith** (227 Kills; 199 Digs; 84 Aces; 21 Assists), junior setter **Natalie Tsai** (620 Assists; 201 Digs; 197 Aces; 66 Kill; 15 Blocks), junior middle hitter **Nayla Norman** (213 Kill; 158 Digs; 38 Aces), junior setter **Taylor Williams** (43 Assists; 19 Digs; 13 Aces), junior middle hitter **Nadia Norma** (41 Kills; 28 Digs; 16 Blocks; 14 Aces), sophomore outside hitter-rightside hitter **Maggie Meeks** (176 Kills; 118 Kigs; 60 Aces; 22 Blocks), sophomore libero **Kaitlin Yarberry** (172 Digs; 55 Assists; 31 Aces) and sophomore middle hitter **Elizabeth Wesley** (72 Kills; 28 Blocks; 10 Digs).

Other key contributors with double figure showings in individual categories included senior outside hitter **Sadie Schroeder** (19 Kills; 14 Digs), junior libero **Carmen Anastasi** (23 Digs) and freshman middle hitter **Sydney McMillan** (10 blocks).

Lakeside represented DeKalb County out of Region 4-AAAAAA, earning a first round, dropping a 3-0 decision on the road to Veterans to close out the season with a stellar 28-9 final overall record.

Coach **Angela Thompson's** Lady Vikings relied on several individual players, with senior setter **Belia Perez** (511 assists; 121 Digs; 73 Aces 38 Kills) and promising freshman setter-rightside hitter **Ava Kehril** (146 digs; 135 Kills; 38 Aces). shining the brightest.

Other key contributors included senior libero-outside hitter **Mason Brown** (226 Digs; 69 Assists; 58 Assists), sophomore middle hitter-rightside hitter **Ty Kleffner** (112 Kills; 38 Aces; 34 Digs; 30 Blocks), senior outside hitter-rightside hitter **Lily Kate Kenyon** (129 Kills; 50 Digs; 39 Aces; 14 Blocks), senior middle hitter- rightside hitter-setter **Abigail Roberts** (104 Kills; 71 Assists; 49 Digs; 35 Aces), freshman outside hitter-rightside hitter **Julie Mount** (36 Kills; 33 Digs; 18 Aces) and freshman outside hitter-rightside hitter **Ella Ralls** (131 Kills; 79 Digs; 68 Aces) .

Sophomore outside hitter-rightside hitter **Erin Lilic** (48 Aces; 88 Digs), and junior rightside hitter **Kamryn El'Woods** (35 Kills; 13 Digs) also reached double figures in at least two of the final scoring categories.

Arabia Mountain and Tucker in AAAAA, Southwest DeKalb in AAAAA, Cedar Grove in AAA and McNair, Redan and Towers in AA rounded out the list of state playoff qualiiers from DeKalb County.

Coach **Bruce Pflieger's** Arabia Mountain squad lost a 3-1 decision to Statesboro in the first round, falling to the solid final overall record of 16-13.

Junior setter-outside hitter **Haley Martin** paced the Lady Ram offensive attack with 158 assists, 111 aces, 73 digs, 24 kills and 11 blocks,, followed by junior leftside hitter **Kai Ture** (112 Digs; 44 Aces; 11 Assists), junior setter **Madison Iriko** (76 Assists; 24 Digs; 20 Aces; 13 Kills), junior middle blocker-rightside hitter **Dior Smith** (42 Kills; 40 Aces; 15 Digs; 14 Blocks).freshman outside hitter-rightside hitter **Aniyah Morrow** (112 Kills; 79 Digs; 56 Aces) and junioi outside hitter **Athalia Henderson** (67 Digs; 63 Kills; 52 Aces).

Coach **Maureen Jekielek** likewise guided Tucker to a state playoff berth out of Area 4-AAAAA, dropping a first round decision to Greenbrier on the way to posting a 17-21 final overall record.

Senior setter-rightside hitter-outside hitter **Gabby Cole** paced the individual standout list for the Lady Tigers, registsering 107 kills, 80 aces, 58 assists and 11 blocks.

Other statistical leaders for Tucker included senior middle blocker **Heather Eggleston** (80 Kills; 58 Aces; 22 Blocks; 13 Assists), junior outside hitter **Kristan Simmons** (84 Kills; 60 Blocks; 56 Aces) and sophomore setter **Tatum Henderson** (78 Assists; 42 Aces; 14 Kills).

Coach **Kristina Parrish** led her Southwest DeKalb squad to a ninth state playoff berth in 10 seasons, losing in three sets to Heritage-Catoosa on the AAAA level in the first round in finishing 20-20 in the record column.

Junior defensive specialist-setter **Nyla Wright** soared highest on the individual statistical side with 157 assists, 107 aces and 32 kills.

Other offensive standouts included sophomore outside hitter **Jah'Tima Jackson** (72 Kills; 46 aces, 21 blocks), senior middle blocker **Genesis Monroe** (39 Aces; 39 Kills; 21 Blocks) and junior outside hitter **Amariah Bonham** (76 Kills; 48 Aces; 13 Digs).

Coach **Gwendolyn Edwards** skippered McNair to the state tournament for only the fourth time in school history, advancing to the AA draw before falling by a 3-0 count to Athens Academy in the first round and posting a final overall record of 18-19.

Senior outside hitter-rightside hitter **Kel'Asia Clayton** shined brightest on the individual level with 130 aces, 118 kills, 96 digs, 12 blocks and 11 assists, followed by junior middle blocker-hitter **Jada Howard** (121 Kills; 78 Blocks; 63 Aces; 19 Digs), senior outside hitter-rightside hitter **Toniyah Butler** (91 Digs; 60 Kills; 35 Aces; 15 Assists), junior setter **Yuko Zheng** (252 assists; 67 Aces; 16 Digs), senior outside hitter-rightside hitter **Amari Lester** (125 Aces; 52 Kills; 26 Digs; 11 Blocks), junior middle blocker-hitter **Jada Williams** (58 Kills; 39 Aces; 36 Blocks) and senior defensive specialist **Breana Case** (61 Aces; 10 Blocks; 10 Digs).

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

REGULAR SEASON:

A. Volleyball is organized on a Region or Area basis with seven (7) state championships. Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.

B. The National Federation Volleyball rules committee has given each state its option about the number of games that determine a match.

1. Region/Area matches shall be best-of-three unless ALL teams in the Region/Area agree (prior to the start of the season) to play best-of-five. Championship matches in the Region/Area Tournament may be best-of-five, and all post-season play after Region/Area Tournaments shall be best-of-five.

2. In all competitions, the deciding set shall be played to fifteen (15) points.

C. Notification of entry in Volleyball must be filed in writing with the GHSA State Office no later than March 1, for the next school year. Schools will be assigned by the GHSA Executive Director to a region or geographic area for competition, and then will be notified of that assignment.

D. Schools must enter team schedules, rosters and weekly game/meet results during the season on MaxPreps and be responsible for updates as needed. This information will support statewide media, event programs, broadcasts partners and GHSA Region Standings. Teams are encouraged to maintain team/individual statistics on MaxPreps.

E. Playing dates:

1. Schools have a maximum of 18 playing dates regardless of whether or not it is a tournament format or head-to-head competition (each day of a tournament equals one playing date). Region/Area and State playoffs are not counted as part of the allotted playing dates.

2. An invitational tournament is defined as five (5) or more schools competing in a single or double elimination format that leads to a champion being declared. The use of pool play is acceptable.

3. The maximum number of days for an invitational tournament is two (2) days.

4. No school shall enter any tournament unless it has been approved by the GHSA Executive Director.

F. MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

1. In accordance with National Federation rules, the use of artificial noisemakers shall be prohibited.

2. Display of signs (larger than 8.5 x 11 inches) in the stands is not allowed during regular season or post season competition.

3. Competitors must stay in uniform while in the competitive area.

4. All varsity Region/Area Volleyball matches shall be officiated by at least two (2) officially-dressed volleyball official who are registered under the GHSA plan for the registration of officials.

(a) The host school must provide registered Line Judges (21 years old or older) who have completed the Line Judge Course at learn.ghsa.net at all Region/Area varsity matches.

(b) The host school must provide an adult (21 years old or older) to maintain the official scorebook and libero tracker sheet at all Region/Area varsity matches.

5. Each school will have a contract with an officials association for regular season matches, play days and invitational tournaments. The host school will be billed by the official's association for all of the officiating fees for these games, including travel.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Each Region/Area may determine its procedure for selecting and ranking its top four (4) teams for the state playoffs. The Region/Area may use regular season records and not have a Region/Area Tournament. The Region/Area may choose to have either a single-elimination (best 3 of 5) or a double-elimination (best 2 of 3) tournament with schools seeded on the basis of their Region/Area records - or may allow schools to play a non-Region/Area schedule and then be seeded into the Region/Area Tournament. That choice must be submitted to the Region or GHSA Volleyball Area Coordinators before the first competition date of the regular season.

1. All finances (including officials' game fees and travel) will be the responsibility of the Region/Area.
2. Region ticket prices are set by the Region. Area ticket prices are to be set at \$6.00.
3. The GHSA will receive 5% of the gross gate receipts.
4. Results of each Region/Area Tournament must be entered in the GHSA MIS system within 24 hours of the completion of the event, but no later than 9:00 a.m., Monday immediately following the Region/Area Tournament.

STATE PLAYOFFS:

The State Volleyball playoffs will consist of five (5) rounds of dual matches. The first three (3) rounds will be held at the site of the higher-seeded team, with the semifinals and championships to be held at neutral sites. (NOTE: A GHSA "universal" coin flip will be held in the event same-seeded teams meet in any round.)

1. All playoff matches will be a best-of-five, single-elimination format and played on:
 - (a) A full court that is free of overhead obstructions (including an overhead scoreboard).
 - (b) A court that is equitable in spacing on both sidelines and endlines.
 - (c) A court that is free of obstructions coming into play such as walls, bleachers, benches, etc.
 - (d) A court that provides adequate lighting.
2. The seeding for the playoffs will be determined by a team's finish in region/area competition or tournament.
3. Finances for all classes through the Quarterfinal Round will be handled as follows:
 - (a) Admission fee for the First and Second Rounds is \$8.00 per day. Admission fee for the Quarterfinals is \$10.00.
 - (b) The GHSA will receive 12% of the gross gate receipts.
 - (c) Officials' fees will be taken from the gross gate receipts and paid by the host school.
 - (d) The visiting team will be paid mileage at the GHSA-approved rate.
 - (e) Any residual funds will be split between the teams.
 - (f) The host school will be entitled to all concession funds.
4. Finances for the Semifinal and Championship matches shall be handled as follows:
 - (a) Ticket prices are TBD and will be published on the GHSA web site.
 - (b) The gate receipts will be sent to the GHSA office.
 1. GHSA will retain 12% of the gross receipts.
 2. GHSA will pay the officials.
 3. Any funds remaining will be disbursed to the competing teams.
5. The number of free admissions for "traveling parties" of participating teams at playoff contests shall be a maximum of 20 players and team essential personnel. Coaches will be admitted with GHSA coaching passes.
6. Line Judges will be supplied by the various officials' associations for all post-season matches.
7. Pep bands with a maximum of 15 members and one (1) adult school personnel member may be allowed. If the home team allows its pep band to attend, it shall also allow the visiting team's pep band to attend.
8. A maximum of sixteen (16) cheerleaders in uniform will be allowed.

LAKESIDE'S THOMPSON RUNNING UP COACHING VICTORIES

Angela Thompson arrived on the local coaching scene in the fall of 1999, taking over for **Sheila Asher** at the helm of the Lakeside basketball program.

Thompson primarily was known for her basketball coaching exploits and proceeded to lead the Lady Vikings to a 29-3 record and trip to the second round of the state Class AAAA tournament in her debut campaign.

The winning ways continued from there, as Lakeside registered five more victorious results in the next six seasons in 2000 (13-8), 2001 (19-8), 2003 (13-11), 2004 (16-9) and 2005 (13-11).

Throw away a 10-11 finish in 2001-02, and the Lady Vikings tallied an impressive 103-50 record in the other five seasons during that stretch.

Only **Eddie Roberts** from 1988-92 (86-37) and **Velinda Purcell** from 1974-78 (84-32) could come close to approaching Thompson's coaching exploits over a five-year period at the helm of the Lakeside basketball push.

Thompson would go on to serve as Lakeside's girls hoop coach for 15 years from 1998-99 to 2012-13, finishing with a 151-199.

Roberts (182-174) from 1981-82 to 1995-96 and Purcell (170-125) from 1965 to 1977 are the only two to win more career decisions as Thompson on the hardwood court for the Lady Vikings.

Thompson would go on to add volleyball to her coaching resume in the fall of 2007 and has since realized even greater success in the 17 years that followed.

Her career victory total of 385, in fact, ranks first among all DeKalb County volleyball coaches.

An impressive string of 13 straight trips to the state tournament ended a year ago, as the Lady Vikings failed to reach the postseason for the first time 2009.

Lakeside ranked among the state elite in the five years from 2009-2013, soaring to postseason appearances in the second round in 2009 and 2010, quarterfinals in 2011, semifinals in 2012 and second round again in 2013.

Thompson enters the 2024 season with a career record of 385-208-1, with 14 winning marks in 16 campaigns overall.

Her combined mark in basketball (151-201) and volleyball (385-208-1) now sits at 536-409-1 overall, a mark that few can best in the DeKalb County coaching circles.
