REMEMBERING LAKESIDE'S GREAT THORNE

Look up and he might be crossing the finish line while the majority of the other runners are still running their second and - in some cases - even first lap of three.

Joe Thorne was that dominating and more during his high school cross country days at Lakeside over two decades ago.

Thorne easily swept to four consecutive individual county cross country crowns, typically running alone hundreds of yards ahead of his closest pursuer in posting winning efforts at county of 16:53 in 1998, 16:42 in 1999, 15:50 in 2000 and 15:31 in 2001. The victorious ways continued on the state level, where Thorne rolled to impressive triumphs as a junior in 2000 (15:40) and senior in 2001 (15:49).

Only Gordon's **James Flack** has managed to post the same level of individual postseason success among DeKalb County entrants. Flack rumbled to three state titles in 1983, 1984 and 1985 and three county golds in 1982, 1983 and 1984 for an equal total of 6.

DRUID HILLS CLAIMS FIRST ALL-SPORTS

In one of the most exciting DeKalb County all-sports trophy races in the 43-year history of the event, Druid Hills claimed the top prize for the first time in school history with 290.0 points to the 289.5 of runner-up Chamblee, 288.0 of Dunwoody, 267.5 of Lakeside and 261.0 of Tucker in rounding out the remainder of the top five.

CROSS COUNTRY HISTORY

DeKalb County boasts a long and proud history in the sport of cross country, ranking among the state elite almost from the inception of the sport on the high school level 66 years ago.

State competition was initiated on an Open Event level only for the boys starting in the fall of 1953, with North Fulton capturing team honors for the first of two straight years.

The Open Event classification continued through 1964, as Druid Hills claimed consecutive team titles in 1957 and 1958 to lead the way among local entrants.

A new format was instituted in 1965, featuring two divisions. That field was then expanded to three divisions starting in 1967 and running through the 1969 campaign.

DeKalb County realized two more championships in this period, as Tucker topped the Division II field in 1965 and Lakeside began a string of nearly a decade of domination by capturing the Division I top prize in 1969.

The Georgia High School Association finally officially sanctioned cross country as a state championship sport in 1970, and DeKalb County immediately flexed its muscles in that first season.

Lakeside's boys won the first of four state Class AAA crowns over a six-year period that fall, while Shamrock also outlasted the field to snare top honors on the AA level.

Local schools soared to two more state championships two years later in 1972, with Lakeside again sitting at the top of the AAA field and Lithonia grabbing the top prize in a combined A and B classification draw.

Walker was runner-up to Lakeside in the AAA battle in 1972, as all-star senior **Ricky Watson** won the second of his two consecutive individual state trophies.

Longtime head coach **Eddie Roberts** would go on to guide Lakeside to two more AAA titles in 1973 and 1975, with only Dunwoody preventing a four-peat while taking the top AAA finish in 1974.

Tony Dipaola and **Mark Thompson** served as two of many individual driving forces during this period of Viking domination in the early 1970s.

Several new faces began popping up on the state championship trophy list starting in 1977, as Avondale, behind two-time winner **Chase Van Valkenburg**, walked away with its lone top prize as the AA boy's winner that fall.

Towers joined Lakeside, Lithonia, Dunwoody and Avondale on the state title list by finishing at the top of the AAA draw for the first and only time in 1980.

The most dominating local state run of all, however, began in the fall of 1981, with Gordon snaring the AAA crown for the first of what would eventually prove to be five consecutive years through the 1985 campaign.

Chamblee, meanwhile, became DeKalb County's seventh boy's state champion in 1986, walking away with the AAA title while ending Gordon's rule at five years.

Gordon's **James Flack**, Chamblee's **Chad Newton** and Lakeside's **Scott Griffith** ranked among many other individual standouts during that period in helping their respective teams push for state honors.

Lakeside nearly returned to the top of the state field for the first time in 25 years in 2000, finishing only two points behind Collins Hill in a brilliant runner-up showing in the AAAA race.

All-world junior **Joe Thorne**, however, did leave little doubt on the individual side, easily storming to the line first in a blistering time of 15:40.35. Thorne repeated as state champion in 2001, winning in an equally sizzling 15:49.

Southwest DeKalb senior **Phillip Burks** captured the 2005 AAAA boy's battle in the splendid time of 16:21, while senior **Nabil Hamid** of Druid Hills grabbed the AAA title in 2008 in 15:50 and junior **Leonel Ayala** of Cross Keys snared the AA crown in 2009 in 16:22 and 2010 in 16:18.

Clarkston added to the team championship list with three straight victorious efforts in AAAA in 2014, 2015 and 2016, while Lakeside junior **Davis Stockwell** captured the boys AAAA individual state crown in 16:34 in 2014.

The Georgia High School Association first officially sanctioned the girls state meet in 1975, with North Cobb (AAA, AA) and Berry Academy (A, B) snaring the top team prizes in that initial battle.

Peachtree gave DeKalb County its first girl's state title in the fall of 1979, outlasting a loaded field to capture top honors on the AAAA level.

Chamblee joined the championship parade two years later, racing to the head of the pack in snaring the AAA team prize in 1981.

Gordon and Dunwoody produced DeKalb County's fourth and fifth girl's state title with victorious efforts in the AAA race in 1982 and AAAA battle in 2012 respectively. Dunwoody netted two more crowns in AAAA in 2014 and 2015.

Shamrock's **Celeste Baker**, Tucker's **Tracey Harrell**, Chamblee's **Stacie Reich**, **Alison Danford** and **Emily Reese**, Dunwoody's **Jeanne Hendrickson** and Lakeside's **Rebecca Mullen** have served as some of the top individual stars. Reese won her fourth straight individual state title in 2007, snaring the AAA prize in 17:56. Lakeside's **Meghan Wetterhall** won the AAAA race with a super 19:12 clocking in 2008. Dunwoody's **Alex Cameron** prevailed in 19:50 on the AAAA level in 2012. Younger sister **Samantha Cameron** added a second state championship to the family name, taking AAAA honors for the Lady Wildcats with a 20:26 clocking in 2015.

2023 CROSS COUNTRY SEASON IN REVIEW

Chamblee's girls returned to postseason glory to serve as the main highlight among many for DeKalb County schools during the 2023 season.

Hakim Felts and **Jennifer Tinnell** coached the Lady Bulldogs to a thrilling triumph at the annual county showdown, registering 49 points to the 52 of Dunwoody and 53 of Lakeside.

The three local powerhouses placed seven runners among the final top 18 individuals in finishing above the two yearly leaders in a fight to the finish.

Freshman standout **Madeline Harron** led the way individually, placing sixth in the impressive time of 22:06.

Freshman **Abigail Mueller** also cracked the top 10 in her county meet debut, crossing the finish line in 10th place in 23:05.

Sophomore **Esther Salaru** (11th; 23:11), freshman **Samantha Yarbrough** (12th; 23:13) and sophomore **Julia Cashin** (15th; 32:29) also cracked the top 20 for the Lady Bulldogs.

Junior **Paige Pendleton** and freshman **Mary-Lawton Jones** rounded out the top 20 individuals for Chamblee, taking 16th (23:29) and 18th (23:46) respectively.

Dunwoody received yet another victorious outing from senior **Claire Shelton**, as the three-time county champion added to her long list of super county showings with a first place time of 20:17.

Senior **Ronnie Amrani** and junior **Abby Reams** joined Shelton in the top 10, soaring to the strong respective finishes of seventh (22:07) and eighth (22:13).

Junior **Hannah Litvak** (19th; 23:55) and junior **Jenna McJunkin** (21st; 24:16) also earned points with top five showings for the Lady Wildcats, while junior **Chloe Warren** (23rd; 24:33) and sophomore **Julia Lovell** (26th; 25:14) also made the trip.

Lakeside also made a serious run for team honors at county, using two top five finishes to soar to third in the final team standings.

Super freshman **Parker White** soared highest for the Lady Vikings, crossing the line in fourth place in 21:57.

Senior **Savannah Spires** also registered an impressive showing for Lakeside, walking away with fifth place in 21:59.

Senior **Harley Martz** of Druid Hills (2nd; 21:07), sophomore **Indie Shuler** of Druid Hills (23:02) and junior **India Thorpe** of Martin Luther King Jr. (22:02; 5th) also earned top 10 efforts at county.

Clarkston's boys, on the other hand, had little trouble waltzing to a sixth county championship in the last 10 years.

The Angoras tallied 22 points in easily besting the 83 total of Dunwoody, placing five runners in the top 10 of the individual standings.

Senior **Abenezer Woellore** edged out senior teammate **Yosef Alemayehu** for the first place prize, hitting the line in 16:50 to the 16:51 of the runner-up.

Clarkston also placed a third runner in the top three, as senior **Claude Tusiime** registered third place in 16:57.

Senior **Jean-Pau Irasu** hit the line in 7th place in 17:28, followed closely by senior **Mengesha Alebachew** in ninth in 17:45, junior **Abdul Mahamat** in 20th in 18:22 and sophomore **Yosef Beseret** in 23rd in 18:40.

Dunwoody's top two finishing list included junior **Oliver Abbot** in 12th in 17:51.60 and sophomore **Alex Loffredio** in 13th in 17:51.80.

Chamblee senior **Matthew Coates** (4th; 17:00.80), Tucker junior **Abeleselam Kerebo** (5th; 17:07.70), Lakeside senior **Andrew Bitsko** (6th; 17:09.60), Tucker senior **Norris Minnis** (18th; 17:35.20),

Clarkston also soared to a stellar runner-up finish at the state class AAAA meet, as Alemayehu led the way with a 13th place individual showing of 16:59.

Woellore closed out his brilliant high school career in style, taking 15th place in the impressive overall clocking of 17:02.

The remaining state participants of the Angoras included Tusiime (16th; 17:03), Beseret (19th; 17:17), Irasubiza (22nd; 17:18), Alebachew (30th; 17:27) and Mahamat (59th; 18:05).
