Key Takeaways

This meeting was focused on answering two key questions related to building capacity/utilization and program offerings.

The Central Region is projected to increase enrollment, unlike other areas.

Some opportunities to reimagine use of space in some elementary schools were identified.

Career Academy expansion and non-traditional high school options were discussed.

Data is needed on program allocations vs. enrollment levels for magnet/ school choice programs.

Next steps include creating traffic maps and consolidating questions from other regional groups.



Topics

Enrollment Trends

The Central Region is uniquely projected to experience an increase in enrollment.

New apartment developments may impact future school enrollment.

There's a need to examine generational turnover in neighborhoods.

Facility Utilization

Some excess capacity in elementary schools was identified.

There are potential opportunities to reimagine the use of space, potentially for pre-K expansion.

There's been an approximate 12% increase in middle school enrollment over the past couple of years.

High schools are generally at good capacity levels, in terms of seats.

Program Expansion Opportunities

Committee members discussed expanding career academy offerings.

Members also explored the concept of full-time, non-traditional career academy high schools.

The future may include examining the allocation of magnet/school choice programs vs. enrollment levels.

Data Needs Identified

Traffic/transportation maps were requested.

Questions regarding details on which schools offer school choice and enrollment numbers surfaced.



A need was identified for program allocation data vs. current enrollment for magnet/school choice programs.

Requests for capacity/enrollment data for elementary pre-K programs also came up.

Community Engagement

SAP Team is planning more interactive community sessions beyond presentations.

A shared document was created to consolidate questions from regional groups.

To share & collaborate on potential solutions, the SAP Team is exploring a visual/gallery walk format.

Next Steps

Create traffic/transportation maps.

Compile and consolidate questions from regional community groups.

Develop visual formats to present potential solutions at future meetings.
