Key Takeaways

All students should have access to diverse school choice programs based on strengths and interests.

DCSD should consider embedding special programs in neighborhood schools to avoid isolating students and reducing resources for local schools.

There is a need to reconsider the current use of school choice and how it affects equity, especially when certain programs may only be available in specific schools.

The district should focus on diversifying program access, particularly for career-focused programs like CTAE, and ensure students gain valuable credentials.

Reimagining school choice involves analyzing current data to assess whether programs are still fulfilling their original goals and if improvements are necessary.



The role of community engagement, including parents and local stakeholders, is crucial in improving neighborhood schools and ensuring equity in school programs.

Data from private and home schools should be considered when reimagining school choice, as it may reveal trends in student enrollment and interest.
