Key Takeaways

Program Complexity: DCSD offers a vast array of specialized programs, but there's a need for better standardization, accessibility, and equitable access to those programs.

School Choice as a Right: There's a push for making school choice a right for all students, but with an emphasis on equity in how programs are accessed and how clear, standardized requirements are put in place.

Reimagining Program Structures: The reimagining process involves understanding current offerings, defining values, and using those values to prioritize program changes or adjustments. This will be an ongoing, iterative process.

Equity and Accessibility: Ensuring equitable access to programs, including transportation and clear program eligibility, has been a consistent theme throughout discussions.



Topics

School Choice and Program Equity

- School choice should be a right but with more equitable access.
- Standardization of program eligibility and clear communication of expectations.
- The school choice process needs to be more transparent and streamlined for families.

Program Offerings and Development

- A wide range of programs exists, but the need for better integration and understanding is critical.
- The gap between middle and high school offerings for certain programs (e.g., IB) requires attention.
- There's a need to address disparities in program access, especially for students with exceptional needs.

Learning from Data and Shaping Future Plans

- There will be continuous learning through data analysis and feedback loops.
- Values and priorities need to be established as a foundation for reimagining programs.
- The decision-making process will incorporate both current data and a forward-looking growth mindset.

Transportation and Access Challenges

- Transportation is a key limiting factor for equitable access to school choice programs.
 - Some programs offer transportation, others don't, contributing to inequalities in access.
- Need to consider transportation infrastructure when evaluating the feasibility of expanding school choice.
