Topics

Guiding Principles Development

- February will involve a group exercise to discuss guiding principles for building.
- The process includes considering historical context, stakeholder impacts, and frameworks.
- Development of these principles will be separate from implementation, which will require further analysis.

Community and Family Engagement



- Strong communication and transparency are essential to build trust and engage families.
- Public acknowledgment of past inconsistencies is necessary for moving forward.
- Marketing and PR strategies must be developed to address the community's concerns and avoid misinformation.

Boundary and Cluster-based Solutions

- Having no boundaries is an idea but faces challenges like transportation and logistics.
- Cluster-based boundaries may provide flexibility, allowing families to choose schools within specific clusters.
- Special programs, like those focusing on career pathways, could be integrated within the clusters.

Partnerships with Industry and Career Pathways

- There's a desire to create specialized schools or programs in collaboration with local industries.
- Potential partnerships with companies like Kia or in sectors like film production could be explored.
- These partnerships could help provide future career opportunities for students, especially those not pursuing college.
