## **Magnet School Eligibility Requirements**

- Reside in DeKalb County
- Submit a complete DCSD School Choice Application
- Submit a complete transcript and discipline history
- Meet all grade level promotion requirements
- Earn a minimum overall 3.0 GPA (rising 10th-12th grade)
- Earn a minimum B+ Average (rising 9th grade)
- Meet all grade level promotion requirements
- Complete a brief video statement
- Submit three academic recommendations

## **Magnet Continuation Guidelines**

- Maintain an overall 3.0 term GPA
- Meet promotion requirements
- Maintain good behavioral standing (no more than 3 disciplinary infractions)
- 20 hours of service learning each school year
- 10 hours of parental involvement each school year

## **Career Pathway Eligibility Requirements**

- Reside in DeKalb County
- Submit a complete DCSD School Choice Application
- Submit a complete transcript and discipline history
- Eligible applicants must meet the following requirements:
  - Entering freshmen must be matriculating to 9th grade for the first time.
  - Entering sophomores must have earned at least 6 credits toward graduation (3 core and 3 elective) and a 2.3 grade point average.
  - Entering juniors must have earned at least 12 credits toward graduation (6 core and 6 elective) and a 2.3 grade point average.
  - Entering seniors must have earned at least 18 credits toward graduation (9 core and 9 elective) and a 2.3 grade point average.

Core: English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language
