Theme School Enrollment

The traditional elementary theme schools mainly receive students from schools that have space constraints. Elementary schools in the immediate community with the greatest need for relief will serve as feeder schools to the elementary theme schools. If a feeder school's enrollment decreases, the feeder school may no longer serve as a theme feeder site. This determination is made annually. The theme middle school receives students from throughout the DeKalb County School District. When a school is no longer a feeder school, new students from this feeder school will not be enrolled; however, siblings of returning students may apply to enroll in the designated theme school.

Eligibility to Apply for a Theme School

•All DeKalb, current, private, and home school students, who will enroll in kindergarten through fifth grades and reside in the identified theme feeder elementary school

Sibling Priority:

Siblings of currently enrolled students only in grades kindergarten through 4, 6 and 7 may be offered enrollment in the same school if the parent applies for enrollment and seats are available. If sibling placement is not available, each sibling will be placed on the waiting list in the order in which the student is selected during the lottery. Please note that this provision DOES NOT apply to pre-kindergarten applicants or applicants of siblings currently enrolled in grades 5 and 8 or late applicants. It is the parents responsibility to indicate sibling on the application.

Program Continuation Guidelines:

- Promotion to the next grade level.
- Adhere to the School Choice Guidelines for attendance and behavior found [here](#).
- Parent volunteer hours are required annually.
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Probation/Exiting Process:

- Students who do not adhere to attendance guidelines outlined in the School Choice Guidelines are subject to probation and removal from the theme school.
- Parents who do not fulfill the required parent involvement hours risk their child's seat continuation being revoked.
- Parents are required to attend all conferences.
