

## International Baccalaureate High School Programs Eligibility and Continuation Guidelines

## • Program Eligibility:

- Reside within any DeKalb County School District Attendance Zone
- $\circ$  **3.0 or higher overall GPA** as of the previous semester for grades 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>.
- $\circ$  **3.2 or higher overall GPA** as of the previous semester for grades 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Complete both the School Choice online application and the Formal IB application found <u>here</u>.
- Two Teacher Recommendations.

\*Preferred course prerequisites are listed on the IB Application Guide & Checklist found <u>here</u>.

## • Program Continuation Guidelines:

- Maintain a 3.0 (or higher) overall grade point average (GPA.
- Maintain a numerical grade of 71 or higher in all core subjects.
- Promotion to the next grade level.
- Students enrolled in the IB Program must complete the required IB courses.
- Adhere to the School Choice Guidelines for attendance and behavior found <u>here</u>.

## • Probation/Exiting Process:

- Students who do not maintain the academic performance criteria will be placed on probation for one semester. Support plans will be provided to any student who has a GPA below the academic performance criteria throughout the probationary period.
- Parents are required to attend all conferences.
- Students who do not have a 3.0 GPA after two consecutive semesters, must exit the IB program and enroll at their home school.
- Students will not be allowed to remain at the IB school if they do not continue in the IB program unless the school is their home attendance area school.
